UK Conformity Assessed (UKCA) marking is a conformity mark that indicates conformity with the applicable requirements for products sold within Great Britain.

BREEAM Certification



BREEAM, first published by the Building Research Establishment in 1990, is the world's longest established method of assessing, rating, and certifying the sustainability of buildings.

CE Marking



The letters 'CE' appear on many products traded on the extended Single Market in the European Economic Area (EEA). They signify that products sold in the EEA have been assessed to meet high safety, health, and environmental protection requirements.

ROHS Compliance



Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS), is a product-level compliance regulation that restricts the use of specific hazardous materials found in electrical and electronic products.

WRAS Approval



The Water Regulations Approval Scheme is an independent UK certification body for plumbing products and materials, helping business and consumers choose compliant products that keep water safe.
